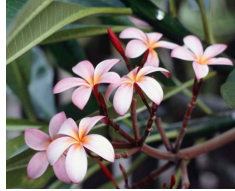

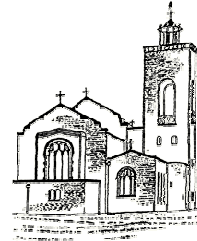

THURSDAY 23 APRIL VISIT TO ST JAMES' FELLOWSHIP

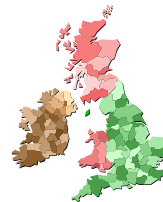
